



## Entry Conditions

### 1.1 Events:

- **24 Hour Race in the Olympiapark Munich (26 – 27 June 2010)**
- **24 Hour Race in Sulzbach-Rosenberg (21 – 22 August 2010 )**
- **Alpenwelt Karwendel BikeDays (13 – 16 May 2010)**

### 1.2

At the time of the event, the participants in the categories „Individual Starter/Two Man Team“ require to be 18 years old and be experienced, as well as we-trained mountain bikers. Participants below the age of 18 are exclusively restricted to start in the categories „Four Man and Eight Man Team“. For this, the respective participants require a statement of consent by a legal guardian.

### 1.3

The registration to one of the above mentioned events represents a binding offer of the Team Leaders („TL“) to the organiser Sog Events GmbH („Sog“). The registration is only possible by the transmittal of the completed and signed registration form ( no faxes, copies or E-mails), or ONLINE under [www.sog-events.de](http://www.sog-events.de). The registration is exclusively conducted per team through the Team Leader, who, with the registration, confirms to have briefed all team participants in regard to the entry conditions.

### 1.4

The Team Leader acknowledges the entry conditions and the rules with his signature or by clicking on to the ONLINE registration. He also simultaneously confirms that he has read and accepts the regulations (also available under [www.sog-events.de](http://www.sog-events.de) per PDFDownload) The contract with Sog comes into effect, when the entry fee has been received.

### 1.5

Type and scope of the contractual obligation are stated in the event Announcement. Any further obligations in regard to personal and technical attendance and catering are only owed subject to respective prior written agreement.

## 2. Obligations

2.1 Every participant is obliged to evaluate his fitness for the event himself. If necessary, he should seek medical consultation. In case of participants under the age of 18, an according written confirmation by a legal guardian must be on hand at Sog. The provision of proper equipment is at the sole responsibility of the participant, who is required to wear head protection that accords to the Ansi/Snell, respectively TÜV-/GS Standards, or the UCI Regulations during the entire race. The instructions and directives of the organiser, as well as the support staff must be strictly complied with.



## 2.2

The time measurement transponder must be returned at the return posts after the race. If, for an important reason, the transponder can not be returned immediately after the event, a postal return to Sog is possible up to 7 days after the event at the latest. In case of the loss of the transponder or the failure to return the same within the above mentioned period, a charge of 80.-Euro is due. This charge, if necessary, will be collected via direct debit, or, in case of foreign participants, will be charged on the credit card (VISA or MasterCard).

## **3. Payment**

Teams with a German bank connection pay the entry fee via bank transfer. Teams from other countries can exclusively pay via foreign bank transfer (IBAN and BIC Code). Eventual bank charges must be carried by the participating team.

## **4. Accreditation**

The TL receives the start qualification documentation for the whole team at the point of time of accreditation (issue of the start numbers-BIB). If the TL is prevented from attending, it is his responsibility to ensure that the start qualification documentation is collected by a person authorised in writing. Unfortunately, we are not able to transmit the documentation.

## 5. Termination by the Sog Events GmbH

### 5.1

Sog is entitled to terminate the contract, if:

- a) the TL or a team member breaches the Regulations and/or the rules and directives, of which the TL is informed prior or during the event;
- b) the TL does not comply with or acts in contrary to the instructions of the Event Management, respectively their staff; c) or if the TL consistently interferes with the realisation of the event or endangers himself or others.

### 5.2

Should the organiser legitimately disqualify a participant, the claim for the entry fee remains unaffected hereof.

## **6. Withdrawal of the Team**

### 6.1

A withdrawal free of charge is possible up to two weeks after the conclusion of the contract (subsequently, after receipt of the payment) through written statement by mail.



## 6.2

At any later stage, the team loses its claim for reimbursement of the entry fee. In case of a withdrawal within the above mentioned period, 50% of the paid entry fee will be credited for a Sog event in the next year.

## 6.3

Should one or several team members be prevented from participating, the TL is entitled to propose suitable substitute participants until the start of the race. This also applies to the whole team.

## 7. Cancellation of the Event / Non-Appearance

In case of the cancellation of the event due to force majeure, non-appearance or termination of the race for reasons the organiser is not responsible, the TL is not entitled to a claim for reimbursement of the entry fee, nor for the compensation of any other damages such as travel and accommodation costs.

## 8. Disclaimer

### 8.1

The participation is at the participant's own risk. The liability of the organisers – also for third parties – is limited to intent and gross negligence. This also applies to the assistants deployed by the organisers. The contractual liability of the organisers for damage, which is not bodily harm is excluded in so far that it is not based on an act of gross negligence or intent.

### 8.2

The organisers are not liable for any impairments of performance in connection with services, which are merely mediated as third party services and are explicitly stated as such in the service description.

### 8.3

The organisers are not liable for any impairments of performance, which are caused by the partial or complete prevention of the TL's participation due to statutory regulations and/or official directives.

### 8.4

The organiser does not assume any liability for any lost pieces of clothing, valuables, equipment or parts hereof, of the TL. They should subsequently be accordingly insured beforehand.



8.5

If the TL calls upon the services of third parties, in particular rescue and emergency medical services, he is obligated to hold free the organiser of any respectively occurring costs. He entitles the organiser to collect eventual costs.

8.6

The TL, together with the registration, declares his consent that the data stated in the registration is collected and transferred for time measurement, positioning and results, and that photographs, movie shots and interviews made in connection with the event may be published without any claim to remuneration.
